Funding success

We are thrilled to share that community development manager Ruth Green has successfully secured over £70,000 from the National Lottery Community Fund. Community recycling

Last year, we partnered up with TerraCycle to offer a small recycling facility for household items that are harder to recycle. We have a number of recycling bins at the Southville Centre, inviting anyone to leave their items in the appropriate bins.

In our year and a half of collecting, we've saved many kilos of waste that would have been destined for landfill – instead it will all be repurposed and we have received small donations of 'cash-back' for the charity.
