

## **Walk six Langton Park (North Street) to Dean Lane (Pink route)**

1. Langton Park. Enter from North Street (pop into Avon News for snacks for the walk) and walk up the hill.

*Gardens worth a glance on Langton Park 3, 22, 38 and 30.*

2. Walk through alleyway on the left at top of cul-de-sac and turn right into Greville Street and right again into Milford Street. Enjoy the front gardens on Milford Street and Home Zone planters.

When you arrive at Merrywood Road turn right.

*Gardens worth a glance on Merrywood Road 66, 52, 50, 40, 38 and 36.*

3. Turn left into Morley Road and right into top of Dame Emily Park. Dame Emily Community Garden is on the right. Turn left and walk along the path that runs along the fenced in play area at the top of the park. Exit out of the top of park and turn right into Lydstep Terrace.

*Gardens worth a glance on Lydstep Terrace 16, 20, 24, 26, 33 and 30.*

4. Exit Lydstep Terrace and turn right onto Kingston Road. At the bottom of Kingston Road cross Dean Lane and continue left until turning right into Thomas Blount Mews. At the end of the mews turn right into Acramans Road. There are several large front gardens on both sides of Acramans Road.

5. At end of Acramans Road, turn left and left again into Alpha Road - there are some nice gardens all along the street. Turn right into Southville Place and do a circuit of the cul de sac.

6. On leaving Southville Place, turn right and then left onto Southville Road - continue to junction of Dean Lane. Turn left and cross over into Stackpool Road.

*Gardens worth a glance on Stackpool Road 7, 10, 12, 13, 20, 21, 35, 49, 52, 56, 61, 63, 69, 70, 71, 74, 76, 78 (these zig zag back and forth across the road, or walkers could complete one side at a time).*

7. Pass Howard Road Home Zone and Patchwork Community Gardens flower beds and onwards.

*More gardens worth a glance 94, 98, 10, 114*

Continue to the top of the road and into Stackpool Road Home Zone cul de sac. Complete cul de sac circuit and continue back down Stackpool Road past Southville Primary School main entrance.

Turn right into Merrywood Road and left into Morley Road alleyway (amazing wisteria on left hand side fences). On entering Morley Road, continue forward into Kingston Road and keep to left hand side.

*Gardens worth a glance on Kingston Road 68, 66, 54, 52 (look up at the wisteria on the house), 48, 46, 44, 34, 32, 30, 28, 20, 10, 2.*

Arrive at Coronation pub on corner of Dean Lane.

Length of walk approximately 1.7 mile (2.81km)

This walk is approximately a 20-25 minutes leisurely stroll.
